

# EARLY CHILDHOOD ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## CISCO COLLEGE / McMURRY UNIVERSITY

The following courses at Cisco College will meet requirements for the major in Early Childhood Education at McMurry University.

- Please refer to the list of GENERAL EDUCATION transfer equivalent courses for those that will meet the general education requirements at McMurry.
- Courses accepted for transfer to McMurry must have a grade of "C" or higher.
- Courses completed at Cisco College are not used to meet the advanced hour requirement at McMurry.
- Admission to the Teacher Education Program at McMurry requires an overall G.P.A. of 2.75 or higher, plus the following THEA/TSI results: (Proposed Texas Education Agency rules may amend these testing requirements – see McMurry University catalog) .

**READING:** THEA 250; Accuplacer Reading Comprehension 90; Compass Reading Comprehension 91; Asset Reading 45, a grade of A or B in SOC or PSYC courses taken within the last 5 years of the date of application to the Teacher Education Program at McM.

**MATH:** THEA 230; Accuplacer Elem Algebra 63; Compass Algebra 39; Asset Elem Algebra 38, or a grade of A or B in College Algebra taken within the last 5 years of date of application to the Teacher Education Program at McM.

**WRITING:** THEA 240; Accuplacer Sentence Skills 80 & Written Essay 6; Compass Writing Skills 59 w/ Written Essay 6; Asset Writing Skills 40 w/ Written Essay 5, or a grade of A or B taken within the last 5 years of date of application to the Teacher Education Program at McM.
